 - Tomatoes
 - Kale
 - Collard greens

 - Squash (acorn, butternut, spaghetti, yellow or zucchini)
- Note: We only accept donations on Mondays from 8am-3pm and are only able to accept the items outlined above.
- Produce must be **fresh** (not wilted or over-ripe), **clean** (washed with potable water and free of bugs, soil, etc.), and **grown without pesticides, manure, and away from pests.**
- With the health of our clients in mind, **we will refuse a donation if it does not meet the criteria outlined above.**
