

Guidelines for Decorating Meal Bags

Project Angel Heart prepares and delivers meals to neighbors living with life-threatening illnesses such as HIV/AIDS and cancer. Many live alone and have little opportunity to visit with people. By decorating meal delivery bags, volunteers help remind our clients that they are appreciated and loved!

Things to do:

- Draw a cheerful design or picture like animals, landscapes, cars, sceneries, mountains, horses, buildings, smiles, stars, the sun, etc.
- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer before decorating.
- Use crayons or markers. Use crayons lightly so they don't smear.
- Feel free to write your name and age on the bags.
- If you want to use stickers or affix anything to the bag, please make sure it is completely stuck on with no chance of falling off.
- Have fun! ☺

Things to avoid:

- DO NOT write messages or words of any kind. We cannot use bags with messages such as "get well soon," "keep faith," "stay strong," "have hope," etc.
- DO NOT draw specific holiday or religious pictures such as crosses, angels, menorahs,
 Christmas trees, Santa, etc.
- DO NOT write "Project Angel Heart" or duplicate our logo *including angels, wings, hearts with wings, etc.*
- DO NOT use glitter, pastels, chalk, tempera paints, or other materials that may rub off.
- DO NOT use crayons on both sides of the bags. If decorating with crayons, only cover one side of the meal bag.
- DO NOT decorate bags if you are sick.
