Things to do:

- Draw a cheerful design or picture like animals, landscapes, cars, sceneries, mountains, horses, buildings, smiles, stars, the sun, etc.
- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer before decorating.
- Use crayons or markers. Use crayons on one side only and lightly so they do not smear.
- Feel free to write your personal name and age on the bags.
- Have fun being creative! ☺ If you make a mistake, make something new out of it!



PLEASE avoid the following:

- DO NOT pick up, decorate, or drop off bags if you are sick.
- DO NOT write messages or words of any kind.
- DO NOT write "Project Angel Heart" or duplicate our logo.
- DO NOT draw specific holiday or religious pictures such as crosses, angels, menorahs, Christmas trees, Santa, etc.
- DO NOT use glitter, pastels, chalk, tempera paints, or other materials that may rub off.
- DO NOT use stickers.
- DO NOT glue or tape anything to the bag.
- DO NOT write a business or organization name on the bags.
